Risk Control Practice

1. Provide all new employees who must drive an agency vehicle with driver safety training within six months of hire.
2. Provide all employees who must drive an agency vehicle with driver safety training at least every three years.
3. Ensure all employees who must drive an agency vehicle are enrolled in the DMV Employer's Pull Notification Program.

Justification

Auto accidents are the second leading cause of loss in terms of frequency and severity for CSRMA since 1987.
