SSMP Implementation Deadlines

If your Agency operates in an area with a population of 10,000-100,000 your Sanitary Sewer Management Plan must be in place by August 2nd of this year. A Sanitary Sewer Overflow Response Plan is an essential component of any SSMP. Effective SSO response procedures can go a long way toward minimizing the impact of SSOs in your jurisdiction.
